Last weekend, our 15th class started their 20-month scholarship period. The new scholarship holders spent three days in Wartaweil at the Ammersee, together with tutors, trainers, and professors, developing six project ideas for this year's call 'Future Societies.' The ideas cover a wide range of topics, from environmental issues and alternative energy concepts to the target group of older people in future societies. Furthermore, political systems and their interactions with society, economy, political communication, and hidden or open stigmatization of upcoming transformations have been chosen as subjects. These are inspiring topics, and we look forward to seeing how the teams will formulate the questions for their student research projects. I wish all participants every success.

At the same time as the kick-off, the #class24 scholarship holders had an intermediate evaluation of their projects. Their seminar program focused on optimizing methods for data analysis, as the five teams will have completed the data collection phase by the end of the year. Both classes were inspired by the magical autumn atmosphere at Ammersee.

This week, 16 representatives from our EuroTeQ network were also able to experience the Bavarian autumn, taking part in a three-day field trip to the 'Munich Entrepreneurial Ecosystem.' The program was organized by our TUMJA office and included more than ten individual appointments at TUM and beyond. One thing is clear: Munich, with its wide-ranging start-up scene, is an actual role model within Europe, and we were delighted to introduce this excellent network to our European partners.

As you can see, the activities of the TUM: Junge Akademie contribute to the consolidation of partnerships and brainwork on a local and international level in order to provide a stable foundation to future shapers of society and to ensure clear minds with an understanding of interrelations, reality, and truth. This is particularly important in the current turbulent times.

I wish you a good time before the end of the year, which is just around the corner.
